

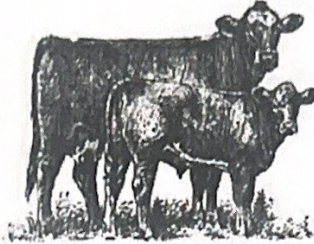

I would say the market was steady to a few dollars lower than last week. Packer market has softened some due to the number of cows coming to market. Packer Bulls were steady as we didn't have any high yielding bulls this week.
